Babu Immanuel Venkataraman, a Langham scholar, is Associate Professor of New Testament at the Theological Centre for Asia College, Singapore. He is a graduate of Leonard Theological College, Jabalpur, MP (BD), United Theological College, Bangalore (MTh), and King's College London, University of London (Ph.D.). Formerly he taught at South India Biblical Seminary (SIBS), Bangarapet and South Asia Institute of Advanced Christian Studies (SAIACS), Bengaluru, as the Professor of New Testament and as the Academic Dean. He also served with The Association for Theological Education by Extension (TAFTEE), Bengaluru, as a senior faculty. He has authored a monograph, contributed a commentary on Acts for the South Asia Bible Commentary, and many articles published in Indian and international journals. He has also contributed short notes on Justice in the Gospel of Luke for *The Justice Bible* (Colorado Springs, Colo.: Biblica, 2015).
